



Balustrade system

Our traditional balustrade system will beautifully complement your deck. DekBoard balustrades can be made up in a number of ways, using traditional top and bottom rails with pickets or glass, glass panels set in-between the rails or the "infinity" look with glass panels and glass clamps.

Our balustrade rails are reinforced with a galvanized steel insert ensuring strength and rigidity. The pickets are pre-cut to height to suit the installation and may be set in a square or diamond orientation within the balustrade rails.







DekBoard maintenance and aftercare

To keep your low maintenance DekBoard product in top condition, we recommend cleaning your decking & balustrade with hot soapy water at least twice a year.

Important points:


- Ensure adequate ventilation underneath your decking and ensure under your decking is free from obstruction.
- Ensure a minimum non-obstructed 25mm ventilation gap between your decking and hot tub.
- Jet washers on a low pressure setting can be used for the decking boards only.
- DO NOT USE JET WASHERS ON FOILED BALUSTRADE.

Cleaning and care:

- Clean your **decking** with a cleaning solution of warm soapy water using a cloth, sponge or soft bristle brush.
- Clean your balustrade with a cleaning solution of warm soapy water using a cloth or sponge.
- DO NOT place ANY hot surfaces or BBQs in the vicinity of the decking.
- DO NOT use any glass/PVC cleaning products or any forms of bleach or solvent.
- **DO NOT** scrub your decking or balustrade with any abrasive products, such as scourers, sandpaper, stiff or wire brushes etc.

Additional tips:

- Some brands of sun cream can permanently stain foiled balustrade finishes.
- DO NOT place rubber mats or rubber backed mats anywhere on the decking area.
- * Please note, to ensure warranty remains intact please ensure above maintenance and aftercare guide lines are adhered to.

We warrant against the loss of water through the shell caused by defect in materials and workmanship for 10 years from the original date of purchase.

Three year component limited warranty

We warrant the electrical components, pumps, air valves, slice valves, and hot tub components against malfunction, leaking or defects in materials or workmanship for a period of three years from the original date of purchase. There are exclusions to the component warranty.

Three year no leak limited warranty

We warrant the hot tub to not leak for a period of three years from original date of purchase.

10 year Permawood™ cabinet limited warranty

We warrant the PermaWood™ cabinet material to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 10 years from the original date of purchase.

Five year heater limited warranty

We warrant the heating element of the hot tub to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for a period of five years from the original date of purchase. Exclusions can be made in cases where improper chemical balance has been found to be the cause of failure.
